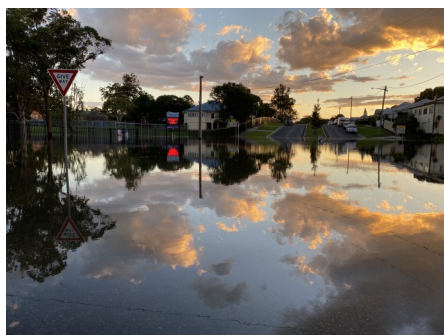
The New Parish Council
