REMEMBERING DOROTHY

Giving thanks for the life and witness of Mrs Dorothy Ann Britten

February 27th, 1938 - December 14th, 2022



Sister Helen CSC writes, "I am grateful for having known Dorothy, and having ministered to her over the past few years by taking her Holy Communion each month (Covid permitting), including on the day she died. Dorothy was not only part of our family here at All Saints Church, but also an Associate of our Community of the Sisters of the Church. During the short monthly services which Dorothy and I shared, we often discussed the particular Bible passage set for the service, and each of us contributed to the intercessions, when Dorothy particularly prayed for members of her family.

On December 12th I phoned Bupa for permission to visit Dorothy the next day. They said they had cases of Covid in the facility but Dorothy was clear, so I could go but needed to take the usual RAT test and wear a mask etc. When I entered her room that day, she asked me to take my mask off! I could see her health had deteriorated since I had seen her in November, so I said we would have a short simple service and she did not have to make all the responses - only say 'Amen' when it was appropriate.

As it was approaching Christmas, I had decided to use the Bible reading for Christmas Eve, Luke 20:27-40, about Joseph and Mary travelling to Bethlehem for the birth of Jesus. I noted in this story, all the difficulties arising from Mary's questionable pregnancy, Joseph accepting this situation, and having to travel from Nazareth to Bethlehem where the only accommodation available was an animal shelter. But also, how among and intertwined in all the pain and suffering connected to the birth of Jesus, was the wonder and glory of God shown by the presence of angels encouraging and strengthening Mary, Joseph and the shepherds presenting their caring and loving messages. I talked about this mixture of suffering and joy with Dorothy and how we often experience the same mingling in our lives.

Dorothy had much pain and suffering in her life, as well as love and joy. On reflection, I can see how relevant the reading was for her. I did not know that in a few hours she would leave her present suffering body and experience and know in a new way the glory and wonder of God's love for her. I give thanks for Dorothy's life, her witness of faith in God and love for God. I believe that now she is experiencing eternal life in God, although still caring for and loving her family and friends here on earth."

The text above was read at the Dorothy's funeral held in January 2023 by Sister Linda Mary CSC on behalf of Sister Helen. Dorothy was buried from All Saints' Church in the East Kempsey Cemetery. We surround her husband and children with our love and prayers at this difficult time. Rest eternal grant to her, O Lord, and let light perpetual shine upon her.
